Hedging is generally a well-understood element of the grain trade, however, the strategies, execution, and record-keeping can sometimes be challenging. This workshop will review the entire hedging process. The workshop is of value to anyone needing a basic understanding of a merchandising program, including key accounting personnel and all other employees who will benefit from a better understanding of the flow of grain through both the cash and futures market.

During this one-day training, you will learn the history of the Board of Trade, reasons for hedging, mechanics of hedging, basis charts, maintaining hedging records, and do problem solving with hands-on hedging training. If time permits, you will be introduced to the concept of options. Nebraska Grain and Feed Association is partnering with INTL FCStone to bring you this valuable educational material.
