## SPEAKERS

**Jess McCluer, Director of Safety and Regulatory Affairs with the National Grain and Feed Association, Washington, D.C.**, is responsible for directing and managing the NGFA's wide-ranging operations programs for grain elevators, feed mills and grain processing plants. He also oversees the NGFA's activities regarding employee safety and industrial health, environmental issues, grain-handling facility design and equipment, grain inspection and weighing issues, grain and biotechnology issues.

**Tom Harmon, Midwest regional safety manager for The Gavilon Group of Omaha, Nebraska** oversees approximately 60 facilities. Tom began his professional career at Bendix, now Honeywell, where he worked from 1980 to 1994. During his time as senior safety engineer, Tom sat on two national committees: the Explosives Committee with the Department of Energy and the Security Committee with both the Department of Energy and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA).

**Tressi L. Cordaro, Shareholder in the Washington, D.C. region office of Jackson Lewis P.C.** advises and represents employers on occupational safety and health matters before federal and state OSHA enforcement agencies. She has advised employers faced with willful and serious citations as the result of catastrophic events and fatalities, including citations involving multi-million dollar penalties.

Ms. Cordaro's unique experience with government agencies involved in OSHA enforcement enables her to provide employers with especially insightful guidance as to how regulators view OSHA compliance obligations, and evaluate contested cases. Ms. Cordaro worked at the U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety & Health Administration developing OSHA standards.
